- A fun way to raise funds,
- Gets people fitter.
- Help with mental issues.
- Helps Rotary reach the public.
 - Introducing businesses, public sectors and leaders in our communities to Rotary.
 - Involving all the Rotary family Rotaract, Interact, etc.
- Making it grow, year on year, to get more publicity







March Against Malaria. Other points and ideas.

- Challenge people, friends & family to walk a number of kms/miles.
- Set a casual target for walking.
- Use social media to promote it.
- Ask your local walking & ramblers clubs to participate.
- Ask businesses and local organisations, in your area, to take it on as a challenge.
- Challenge local council workers, civil servants, police and fire services, health workers, local supermarket staff and other larger organisations in your area.
- Involve your Community







March Against Malaria. Other points and ideas.

It may help to:

- Appoint a District Rotary MAM Coordinator for 2023/24 and 2024/25.
- Ask clubs to appoint coordinators who are good at organising.
- Involve local walking/rambling clubs.
- Work with other Rotary clubs.
- Use your web page and social media platforms using the hashtags.
- Include details about Malaria eradication and the partnerships we have formed







March Against Malaria. Other useful information.

- RAM has already raised over \$2.4 million towards malaria vaccine research.
- Over \$2M for the distribution of cost-effective malaria interventions.
- RAM is part of the well-established RAWCS.
- It works closely with the Global Fund and regional health authorities.
- The funds we raise reach the people, and places, most in need.
